Meet Minutes

- The No. 19-ranked West Virginia University gymnastics team continues its season-opening road trip at Pitt on Friday, Jan. 13, at 6:30 p.m., inside Fitzgerald Field House, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
- Friday is the first of three meets against the Panthers this season. WVU will return to Pittsburgh for a quad-meet on March 3 and also play host to Pitt in a quad-meet at the WVU Coliseum on March 5.
- The Mountaineers debuted at No. 19 in the first Road to Nationals rankings of the 2017 season. It is the team's highest position since earning the No. 16 ranking in the Feb. 25, 2013, GymInfo Poll. WVU was nationally ranked for six weeks last season.
- Three gymnasts own four national rankings. Sophomore Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 4 on vault and No. 22 on floor exercise. Junior Jordan Gillette ranks No. 5 on balance beam, and classmate Zaakira Muhammad ranks No. 21 on vault.
- Four Mountaineer freshmen made their career debuts at Maryland: Chloe Cluchey, Cassidy Cumber, Abby Kaufman and Julia Merwin.
- Should WVU win Friday night, it will mark the first time the squad started a season 2-0 since 2011.

WVU vs. Pitt

- WVU and Pitt first met in 1974, the first season for WVU gymnastics.
- The Mountaineers own a 57-12-2 all-time series edge over the Panthers, a former conference opponent in the East Atlantic Gymnastics League (EAGL). WVU swept Pitt, earning a win at the Coliseum on March 11 and a victory at Fitzgerald Field House on March 13.

The Last Meeting

- The No. 25-ranked Mountaineers defeated the Panthers for the second time in less than 48 hours with a 195.825-195.675 win at Pitt on March 13.
 - WVU earned a 49.05-48.625 win on vault. The squad was edged on bars (48.7-48.625), beam (48.925-48.85) and floor (49.425-49.3).
 - Tiara Wright put together a career-defining performance, earning career highs on bars (9.9), beam (9.85) and floor (9.8) and winning bars and floor.
 - Three Mountaineers tied for the vault win with 9.85 marks: Kirah Koshinski, Zaakira Muhammad and Jaida Lawrence. Koshinski also paced on floor and finished in a tie for second place with a 9.9 score.
- #### A Look at the Panthers
- Pitt opened its 2017 campaign with a 194.375-192.8 loss to Ohio State on Jan. 7, at Fitzgerald Field House. The team finished with marks of 48.35 on vault, 48.425 on bars, 47.125 on beam and 48.9 on floor.
 - Fifteen Panthers competed on Saturday, and senior Tracey Pearson finished second in the all-around with a 38.9 mark.
 - Freshman Alecia Petrikis was named the EAGL Rookie of the Week on Jan. 10. She finished second on floor (9.825) against OSU.

Noteworthy

WVU has not counted a fall in 2017 ... the Mountaineers are 1-0 on the road this season and went 6-7 on the road in 2016 ... senior Alexa Goldberg paces the team with 1,021.725 points ... Goldberg needs 374.575 points to break onto the WVU Career Points Top 20 List ... she ranks No. 1 on the team, No. 17 in program history, with 11 career scores of 9.9 or better ... eight of her marks have been earned on bars, the third-best total in WVU history ... she needs one more bars score of 9.9 or better to move to No. 2 all-time ... she owns a team-best 22 career wins, with 17 victories on bars ... sophomore Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 2 on the team, No. 21 in program history, with eight career scores of 9.9+ ... she has scored 9.8 or better in all but nine of her 38 collegiate routines ... she shows six career vault scores of 9.9 or better, the eighth-best total in program history ... junior Robyn Bernard owns 473.6 career points and needs 26.4 more points to hit the 500-point plateau ... junior Jordan Gillette (444.175) is 55.825 points short of the 500-point plateau.

2017 Highlights

• Meet 1: WVU at Maryland (1/8)

The Mountaineers opened the 2017 season with a come-from-behind, 194.4-193.95 win at Maryland on Jan. 8, inside the XFINITY Center. Down 146.025-145.725 after three events, the team strung together four scores of 9.75 or better to close its beam rotation with a 48.675 total, good enough to edge the Terrapins 47.925 showing on floor.

Kirah Koshinski paced the Mountaineers on three events, earned two wins and matched two career highs in a strong opening showing. Koshinski finished first on vault (9.925) and floor (9.85) and tied for second place on beam (9.8); the vault and beam marks were career highs.

Jordan Gillette won beam with a career-high 9.9 showing.
