Meet Minutes

- The West Virginia University gymnastics team opens its 2017 home season at the WVU Coliseum on Saturday, Jan. 21, against No. 1-ranked and defending NCAA National Champion Oklahoma, at 7 p.m.
- Saturday also is the Mountaineers' Big 12 Conference opener. The Sooners have won the last five Big 12 titles and nine overall.
- WVU is unranked this week after opening the season ranked No. 19 in the first Road to Nationals Rankings on Jan. 9.
- Three gymnasts own four national rankings. Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 16 on vault (9.888 avg.) and No. 26 on floor exercise (9.863 avg.). Jordan Gillette ranks No. 7 on balance beam (9.9 avg.), and Zaakira Muhammad ranks No. 32 on vault (9.85 avg.).
- While no WVU gymnast has competed in the all-around this season, seven Mountaineers have competed in at least three different lineups.

WVU vs. Oklahoma

- The Mountaineers are 0-7 against the Sooners since joining the Big 12 in 2013. WVU is 1-12 in the all-time series.
- Saturday is the fourth regular-season meeting between the teams as conference foes and the second in Morgantown.

The Last Meeting

- WVU tallied 195.925 and finished in third place at the 2016 Big 12 Gymnastics Championship on March 19, at the Dr. Pepper Arena, in Frisco, Texas. No. 1 OU scored 198.05 and won its fifth straight conference title. No. 10 Denver finished second with a 196.725 mark, and Iowa State placed fourth with a 195.35 total.
- WVU's total was its second-best mark ever earned at the Big 12 Championship and its second-highest road score of the 2016 season.
- An OU gymnast won at least a share of all five individual titles. Kirah Koshinski, the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, finished third on vault with a 9.9 mark, the second highest score earned.

The Last Meeting in Morgantown

- WVU scored a season-high 196.375 and finished in third place at the 2014 Big 12 Gymnastics Championship, on March 22, in front of 2,112 fans at the WVU Coliseum. No. 3 OU won its third straight title with a 198.0 score, the WVU Coliseum record for the best mark earned by any team. ISU scored 196.65 and finished in second place.
- Hope Sloanhoffer finished first in the all-around with a 39.425 mark, winning the program's first Big 12 title.

A Look at the Sooners

- Six gymnasts who combined for 12 All-America honors returned for OU this season following its win at the 2016 NCAA National Championships. The title was the team's second in three years and first outright.
- OU opened the 2017 slate with wins at home over No. 3 Alabama (197.75-196.7) and No. 8 UCLA (198.025-196.825).
- A trio of Sooner gymnasts have swept the Big 12 weekly awards each week this season, including two-time reigning Big 12 Newcomer of the Week, Maggie Nichols, a member of the Gold Medal, 2015 U.S. Women's World Championships team. Nichols finished sixth at the 2016 U.S. Olympic Team Trials.

Noteworthy

The Mountaineers are 0-0 at the WVU Coliseum this season and went 5-1 at home in 2016 ... Alexa Goldberg paces the team with 1,050.125 points ... she needs 346.175 points to break onto the WVU Career Points Top 20 List ... Goldberg ranks No. 1 on the team, No. 17 in program history, with 11 career scores of 9.9 or better ... eight of her marks have been earned on bars, the third-best total in WVU history ... she needs one more bars score of 9.9 or better to move to No. 2 all-time ... she owns a team-best 22 career wins, with 17 victories on bars ... Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 2 on the team, No. 21 in program history, with eight career scores of 9.9+ ... she has scored 9.8 or better in all but 10 of her 41 collegiate routines ... she shows six career vault scores of 9.9 or better, the eighth-best total in program history ... Koshinski (402.85) needs 97.15 points to reach the 500 career-point plateau, while Jordan Gillette (444.175) needs 55.825 points ... WVU has counted only one fall this season.

2017 Highlights

• Meet 1: WVU at Maryland (1/8) | College Park, Md.

The Mountaineers opened the 2017 season with a come-from-behind, 194.4-193.95 win at Maryland on Jan. 8, inside the XFINITY Center. Down 146.025-145.725 after three events, the team strung together four scores of 9.75 or better to close its beam rotation with a 48.675 total, good enough to edge the Terrapins' 47.925 showing on floor.

Kirah Koshinski paced the Mountaineers on three events, earned two wins and matched two career highs in a strong showing. Koshinski finished first on vault (9.925) and floor (9.85) and tied for second place on beam (9.8); the vault and beam marks were career highs.

Jordan Gillette won beam with a career-high 9.9.

• Meet 2: WVU at Pitt (1/13) | Pittsburgh, Pa.

Despite defeating the Panthers on three of the four events, the Mountaineers suffered a 194.025-193.875 loss at Pitt on Jan. 13, at Fitzgerald Field House.

WVU won vault (48.8), beam (48.425) and floor (48.85) but could not overcome a 47.8 showing on bars.

Kirah Koshinski earned two event titles, tying Zaa-kira Muhammad for the vault win with a 9.85 mark and scoring 9.875 for the floor victory. Carly Galpin made her season debut on beam and tied for first place with a 9.825 score, while Tiara Wright paced the team on bars and finished third overall with a 9.8.
