Meet Minutes

- The No. 25-ranked West Virginia University gymnastics team competes in its first quad-meet of the season at the WVU Coliseum on Sunday, Jan. 29, against No. 7 Denver, Temple and Towson at 2 p.m.
- Sunday is the Mountaineers' second straight meet against a Big 12 opponent. It is the Pioneers' Big 12 opener.
- WVU returned to the Road to Nationals Rankings on Jan. 23 after a one-week absence. The Mountaineers debuted in the rankings at No. 19 on Jan. 9.
- Two gymnasts own three national rankings. Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 13 on floor exercise (9.892 avg.) and No. 18 on vault (9.875 avg.). Zaakira Muhammad ranks No. 29 on vault (9.85 avg.).
- Currently, a freshman or sophomore is featured in 11 of the Mountaineers' 24 lineup spots.
- Kirah Koshinski (floor) is the first Mountaineer gymnast in 2017 to score 9.95 or better on any event. Four different gymnasts tallied the mark on floor in 2016.

WVU vs. Denver

- The Mountaineers trail the all-time series against the Pioneers, 4-6. DU has been ranked in the top 20 in each of the teams' meetings since 2010.
- DU joined the Big 12 Conference as an affiliate member in 2016 and finished second at the Big 12 Conference with a 196.725 total. WVU placed third with a 195.925 mark.
- In their last meeting at the WVU Coliseum, the Mountaineers fell, 195.425-194.6, to the No. 18 Pioneers on Feb. 13, 2015. Alexa Goldberg won bars outright with a 9.875 score.

WVU vs. Temple

- The Mountaineers own a 43-1 all-time series edge over the Owls. The teams last met at the 2016 Unite for Her Pink Invitational in Philadelphia, on Feb. 26. WVU finished first (196.225), and Temple placed fourth (191.625).
- In their last meeting at the WVU Coliseum, No. 16 WVU earned a 196.375-191.625 win on March 3, 2013.
- The Owls are led by second-year coach Umme Salim Beasley, a former Mountaineer gymnast.

WVU vs. Towson

- WVU is 20-10 all-time against the Tigers. The Mountaineers earned the win in their last meeting, a 195.35-194.975 victory at New Hampshire on Feb. 8, 2015.
- In their last meeting at the WVU Coliseum, the Mountaineers earned a 195.5-192.425 victory on Feb. 2, 2014.

A Look at the Field

- For the first time in program history, DU is ranked within the top-seven nationally for at least three straight weeks, as the Pioneers sit at No. 7 for the third straight week. DU is coming of a 196.875, second-place showing at Utah on Jan. 20. The score was the fifth-best road mark in program history. Freshman Sam Ogden is the reigning Big 12 Newcomer of the Week after scoring a career-best 9.9 on bars at Utah.
- The Owls scored a 193.375-189.35 win over Ursinus on Jan. 22, the second-best mark in Temple history. Daisy Todd, the reigning ECAC Rookie of the Week, ranks 10th in the all-around (38.6 avg.) in the Northeast Region.
- Towson tallied a season-best 194.05 in a loss to No. 14 George Washington (196.0) on Jan. 22.

Noteworthy

The Mountaineers are 0-1 at the WVU Coliseum this season and 0-1 against ranked teams ... Alexa Goldberg paces the team with 1,088.15 points ... she needs 308.15 points to break onto the WVU Career Points Top 20 List ... Goldberg ranks No. 1 on the team, No. 17 in program history, with 11 career scores of 9.9 or better ... eight of her marks have been earned on bars, the third-best total in WVU history ... she needs one more bars score of 9.9 or better to move to No. 2 all-time ... she owns a team-best 22 career wins, with 17 victories on bars ... Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 2 on the team, No. 19 in program history, with nine career scores of 9.9, including six career vault scores of 9.9 or better, the eighth-best total in program history... she has scored 9.8 or better in all but 11 of her 44 collegiate routines ... Koshinski (432.25) needs 67.75 points to reach the 500 career-point plateau, while Jordan Gillette (463.675) needs 36.325 points ... WVU has counted only one fall this season.

• Meet 1: WVU at Maryland (1/8) | College Park, Md.

The Mountaineers opened the 2017 season with a come-from-behind, 194.4-193.95 win at Maryland, inside the XFINITY Center. Down 146.025-145.725 after three events, the team strung together four scores of 9.75 or better to close its beam rotation with a 48.675 total, good enough to edge the Terrapins' 47.925 showing on floor.

Kirah Koshinski paced the Mountaineers on three events, earned two wins and matched two career highs in a strong showing. Koshinski finished first on vault (9.925) and floor (9.85) and tied for second place on beam (9.8); the vault and beam marks were career highs.

Jordan Gillette won beam with a career-high 9.9.

• Meet 2: WVU at Pitt (1/13) | Pittsburgh, Pa.

Despite defeating the Panthers on three of the four events, the Mountaineers suffered a 194.025-193.875 loss at Pitt, inside Fitzgerald Field House.

WVU won vault (48.8), beam (48.425) and floor (48.85) but could not overcome a 47.8 showing on bars.

Kirah Koshinski earned two event titles, tying Zaakira Muhammad for the vault win with a 9.85 mark and scoring 9.875 for the floor victory. Carly Galpin made her season debut on beam and tied for first place with a 9.825 score, while Tiara Wright paced the team on bars and finished third overall with a 9.8.

• Meet 3: WVU vs. No. 1 Oklahoma (1/21) | Morgantown

The Mountaineers tallied a season-high score in a 197.925-195.55 loss to No. 1 Oklahoma in their home season opener at the WVU Coliseum. WVU was powered by season-high marks of 49.2 on floor and 48.8 on uneven bars.

Kirah Koshinski matched her career-best floor score of 9.95 and tied for second place, the highest individual finisher for WVU. She also paced on vault and tied teammate Zaakira Muhammad for fifth place with a 9.85. Tiara Wright paced on bars for the second straight week with a season-high 9.825, and Brooklyn Doggette led the team on beam with a 9.825 mark, matching a career high first set in 2015.
