### QUICK HITTERS

- No. 22/25-ranked WVU opens the 2016-17 season on Saturday, Nov. 12, against Charleston Southern. West Virginia is seeking its ninth win in 10 seasons in lidlifters.
- The Mountaineers and Charleston Southern are meeting for the first time on the hardwood. WVU holds a 9-2 record against Big South competition.
- West Virginia is ranked No. 22 in the Associated Press and No. 25 in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches preseason polls. The Mountaineers are ranked in both preseason polls for the fourth time and the first since the 2014-15 season.
- Kristina King was named the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year, as selected by the league's head coaches. King was the WBCA and the NJCAA National Player of the Year last season after leading Gulf Coast State to a NJCAA National Title.
- Veteran returnees Lanay Montgomery and Tynice Martin were named Preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

### Series Tidbits:

- WVU and CSU have never met.
- The Mountaineers own a 9-2 record (.818) against current members of the Big South Conference.
- WVU last played a Big South team last season, defeating Longwood 74-43 at the WVU Coliseum on December 16, 2015.

## SCOUTING CSU

- Charleston Southern returns nine letterwinners from last season's team that finished 14-17 overall and 8-12 in the Big South for a seventh-place finish.
- Alyssa Mann returns as the Buccaneers' top scorer, averaging 13.7 points per game.
- Mann, a redshirt senior guard, was selected to the 2016-17 Big South All-Conference Second Team.
- Elyse Kiploks returns as the top rebounder for CSU, pulling in 5.8 rebounds per game in 30 contests.
- As a team last season, Charleston Southern averaged 58.5 points per game and allowed opponents to score 60.3 points per contest. The Buccaneers shot 35.9 percent from the field and 26.7 from behind the arc.
- Charleston Southern was picked seventh overall in the Big South annual coaches poll.

## ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won 24 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers' last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The Mountaineers are 96-7 (.932) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.

## WVU IN PRESEASON TOP 25

- The Mountaineers were tabbed No. 22 in the Associated Press Preseason Top 25 Poll and No. 25 in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches Preseason Top 25.
- The Mountaineers are in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (2/4), Texas (8/6), Oklahoma (16/18) and West Virginia (22/25).

## PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- Three Mountaineers earned preseason recognition.
- Kristina King was named the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year.
- Lanay Montgomery and Tynice Martin earned Preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.
- King originally signed with West Virginia in November 2013, before spending the past two seasons at Gulf Coast State.
- She was selected as the 2016 National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Player of the Year and the WBCA Junior/Community College Player of the Year.
- Additionally, she was All-America first team selection by the NJCAA and WBCA. She was also tabbed the nation's top junior college player by Dan Olson of the Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.
- Martin returns after earning Big 12 Freshman of the Year and Big 12 All-Freshman honors and being named a finalist for National Freshman of the Year by the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) in 2016.
- The Atlanta native averaged 10.3 points and grabbed 3.2 rebounds in 35 games. Martin shot 40.3 percent (140-of-347) from the field.
- Montgomery, a senior captain from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, returns after garnering All-Big 12 Second Team honors as well as being tabbed to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team.
- Montgomery led WVU with 284 rebounds and 97 blocks. She set a school single-season record with a 58.9 field goal percentage (116-of-197). Montgomery's 2.8 blocks per game anchored a Mountaineer squad that won a NCAA Statistical Award with 6.5 blocks per game.

## CAREY RETURNS FOR 16TH SEASON

- Coach Mike Carey returns for his 16th season at the helm of the Mountaineer women's basketball program.
- Mike Carey recorded his 600th career win at the collegiate level with WVU's 72-35 victory over Kansas on Jan. 16, 2016.
- With a win over Morehead State on Dec. 2, 2015, Carey surpassed Kittie Blakemore as WVU's all-time wins leader.
- He produced 288 wins at Salem and has 322 victories at West Virginia.
- His .654 winning percentage in 15 seasons at WVU is a program-best.

### CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

### GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

## WVU COLISEUM RENOVATIONS

- Construction work continues at a frenetic pace as the finishing touches are being made to West Virginia University's most iconic athletic structure - the WVU Coliseum.
- Phase one work began last spring on the 46-year-old facility's concourse and will continue through December as part of a \$23 million renovation project.
- Phase two will involve seating improvements to the arena's interior and will start at the conclusion of the 2016-17 basketball season. This is by far the most significant upgrade the Coliseum has experienced since the first men's basketball game was played here on December 1, 1970.

## MONTGOMERY MAKING HER MARK

- Senior Lanay Montgomery achieved multiple personal milestones last season, including averaging a career-high 8.2 points per game and a career-best 8.1 rebounds per game.
- Montgomery's 2.8 blocked shots per game ranked second in the conference.
- The Pittsburgh native set a school single-season record with a 58.9 field goal percentage (116-of-197).
- Coming into the 2016-17 campaign, Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 231 career blocked shots. She is 40 away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is 10th on the Big 12 Conference's career blocks list.
- She has 625 total rebounds in three seasons and is 91 away from reaching WVU's top 10.

## WHO'S STEPPING UP?

- Coach Mike Carey, the program's all-time wins leader with 322 career victories, realizes the Mountaineers will have a different look after the graduation of WNBA first round draft pick Bria Holmes.
- In the past three seasons, WVU has produced three of the program's top-six scoring efforts including a school record 2,581 points in 2014, 2,484 points in 2015 (3rd) and 2,470 points (6th) in 2016.
- Teana Muldrow is the Mountaineers' returning scoring, averaging 10.6 points per game from the bench. Muldrow led WVU with a 45.3 three-point field goal percentage (57-of-88).
- Other key returners include starting point guard Chania Ray, who dished out 56 assists in 24 games. Sophomores Katrina Pardee (5.9 ppg), Alexis Brewer (3.9 ppg) and Anja Martin (0.5 ppg) also return.
- Desiree Rhodes, a senior post, returns after averaging 1.7 rebounds and 1.0 points per game.

- Junior Teana Muldrow needs 388 points to become the 33rd Mountaineer to reach the 1,000-point club.
- Muldrow ranked second on the team with a 49.6 field goal percentage (127-of-256) last season and was the team's leading bench scorer with 10.6 points per game.
- She led the Big 12 Conference with a 45.3 three-point field goal percentage and was 51.3 percent from behind the arc in conference-only games.

- West Virginia University women's basketball coach Mike Carey announced the signing of three student-athletes to National Letters of Intent (NLIs) for the 2017-18 season.
- Destiny Harden (Chicago, Illinois/Morgan Park), Ashley Jones (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania/Neumann and Goretti Catholic) and Makayla Stanley (Glen Allen, Virginia/Glen Allen) are the 2017 Mountaineer signing class.
- West Virginia's recruiting class is ranked No. 17 by ESPN HoopGurlz and No. 20 by the BlueStar Basketball Report.
- Harden averaged 13.2 points, 11.4 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 2.0 steals per game as a junior at Morgan Park High in Chicago. The 6-foot forward/guard garnered All-State Second Team honors from the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association (IBCA). She also earned all-state recognition from the Chicago Tribune and Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette last season.
- Jones played three seasons at Cheltenham High before transferring to Saints John Neumann and Maria Goretti Catholic High in the fall.
